Professor Angela Campbell

Angela Campbell is a Professor at the Faculty of Law and a Member of the Centre for Human Rights and Legal Pluralism at McGill University. She has served as the Director of the McGill Institute of Comparative Law (2008-2012) and Convener of the McGill Research Group on Health and Law (2006-2012).

Abstract

Wait times for medical services represent a critical problem faced by numerous patients in Canada afflicted with various types of injuries and illnesses. This presentation explores the phenomenon of expanding wait times in the delivery of care and treatment to oncology patients across Canada, and contemplates avenues of legal recourse that patients may pursue for injury or loss sustained as a result of undue wait times for cancer care.

Professor Campbell's presentation will be followed by brief presentations reflecting on experiences in Victoria, and discussion.
